**NOS GRANITES CISELÉS, BLANC 2024 AOP CROZES-HERMITAGE**

A delicious white with texture, balance and focus. On the nose it shows sliced apples, dried herbs and stones. Medium-bodied with a seductive character. Lovely blanched almond and white flower flavors and a succulent finish. Drink now.

**HOMMAGE À JEAN, ROUGE 2024 AOP SAINT-JOSEPH**

A delicious syrah that's driven and textured. It shows aromas of plums, dark cherries, black pepper and some roasted meat. Vivid and succulent, with a crunchy and peppery finish. Drink or hold.

## **J.BOUTIN CROZES-HERMITAGE LES VEDIAS 2024**

Tasted out of vat, the 2024 Crozes-Hermitage Les Védias offers perfumed red and black fruits on the nose intermixed with leafy herbs and gamey, earthy notes. It's medium-bodied, has firm tannins, and reasonable length. It's a challenging tank sample that will need time to come together.

## **J.BOUTIN SAINT JOSEPH HOMMAGE À JEAN 2024**

Based on 98% Syrah and 2% Roussanne from predominantly granitic soils with patches of schist and limestone, the 2024 Saint Joseph Hommage À Jean sports a deep purple hue as well as ripe blue and red fruits, crushed stone, pepper, and liquid violet notes. It's medium to full-bodied, has a concentrated, layered mouthfeel, ample minerality, and a great finish. It's a beautiful Saint Joseph in the making and does incredibly well in the vintage.

## **PARCELLE DE JEAN, ROUGE 2019 SAINT JOSPEH**

Lots of attractive, sandalwood, camphor, and ground pepper notes emerge from the 2019 Saint Jospeh Parcelle DeJean, anicely textured, savory, complex, meaty Saint Jospeh that has plenty of both red and black fruits. All destemmed Syrah aged mostly in tank (a small part was in 500-liter barrels), it's ideal for enjoying over the coming 7-8 years or so.

## **LES HAUTS GRANITES, ROUGE 2022 CROZES-HERMITAGE**

Fresh plums, darker raspberries, peppery herbs, and flowery incense notes all emerge from the 2022 Croze-Hermitage Les Hauts Granites, a medium bodied, nicely concentrated, focused Crozes that has some undeniable minerality, building tannins, and a great finish. Still resting mostly in tank, it's going to need 2-3 years of bottle age but is impressive.

## **J.BOUTIN AOP CROZES-HERMITAGE NOS GRANITES CISELES 2024**

Cette cuvée issue de l'extrême nord de l'appellation brille par son éclat et sa belle définition. Dans un esprit épuré, avec une tension qui porte la finale, il devrait très bien évoluer sur une décennie.

*This cuvée from the extreme north of the appellation shines with its brilliance and beautiful definition. In a refined spirit, with a tension that carries the final, it should evolve very well over a decade.*

**PARCELLE DE JEAN, ROUGE 2019 SAINT JOSPEH**

Menthol and black cherries mark the nose of the 2019 Saint Josphe Parcelle de Jean. It's full-bodied and concentrated, with a bit more structure than many of its speers. Those firm, dusty tannins continue through the finish but ultimately give way to the fruit, so this looks to have up to a decade of aging potential.

## **PARCELLE DE JEAN, ROUGE 2020 SAINT JOSPEH**

Shows a supple, delicious mix of cherry and plum backed by warm spices, toasty cedar and chalky minerality. Reveals charred apple wood and smoked bacon notes, while the chalky minerality brings a beautiful textural component. Drink now through 2030, 241 cases made, 100 cases imported.

**PARCELLE DE JEAN, ROUGE 2021 SAINT JOSEPH**

Lovely nose of pure blackberry and a touch of plum. This is an authentic and genuine style of St-Joseph not covered up by oak. It has lovely freshness, good balance, an appealing rusticity, and the tannins are quite bold, so give it a year.

**LES HAUTS GRANITES, ROUGE 2022 CROZES-HERMITAGE**

Soft, ripe and juicy, seductive and easy to drink. Alcohol is in check despite the ripeness of the fruit, the tannins are soft, supple and sueded textured. Fairly long finish. Very good for a 2022 Crozes.

**LES VEDIAS, ROUGE 2022 CROZES-HERMITAGE**

Smoky bacon and bay leaf, a classic Crozes aromatic profile. Ripe blackberry fruits in the mouth, this is juicy, with good acidity and a fresh feel to the finish. Well balanced, ripe but not excessively so, with supple tannins.

A dense and inviting nose, dark fruits, lavender, blueberry and black olive. Lots of juicy fruit here supported by racy acidity and well-judged firm tanning. A freshness to the fruit and an appealing, long and layered finish.

An appealing nose of dark, iron and earth. Firm yet rounded tannins and a spiced note on the mid palate. Good tension and needs the tannins just to integrate a little- a long and cool, fresh finish. Nice energy and purity here.

**LES HAUTS GRANITES, ROUGE 2022 CROZES-HERMITAGE**

The 2022 Crozes-Hermitage Les Hauts Granites was vinified with 10% wholeclusters. The intentionnaly late-harvested fruit translates into punchy raspberry preserves, black cherry compote and licorice. Roasted herbs and minty shadings add more complexity. Medium-bodied and concentrated, the 2022 offers a juicy core of jammy fruit and remarkable intensity on the savory finale.
